DEAR DIVERS!

We've put together a list of essentials you'll need on board JPMarine to help you save time and be fully prepared for your scuba trip!



CHECK-LIST

PAPERWORK

- Insurance containing underwater activities, printed
- All your scuba certifications, cards (OW, AOWD, Nitrox etc)

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

- Passport, ID card
- E-Visa or 25 USD cash to purchase VISA upon arrival in Egypt

TOILETRIES

- Biodegradable sunscreen
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Personal hygiene items
- Extra towel if needed (aboard we will provide 2 towels per person per week, towels are not gonna be exchanged)

CLOTHING

- Rash guard or dive skin
- Swimwear
- Casual clothing
- Hat and sunglasses
- Sandals / water shoes

DIVE GEAR

- Mask, snorkel
- Buoyancy Control Device (BCD)
- Regulator set (all tanks aboard are DIN type, please bring adaptor for YOKE type regulator)
- Dive Computer (one per each diver)
- Wetsuit
- Fins open type
- Boots to use with fins
- Dive light and backup
- SMB (one for each diver)

Hooks and gloves are prohibited to be used during underwater activities on the Red Sea

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Aboard medical kit is equipped with basic essentials aimed at addressing minor injuries and common conditions (aboard provided ONLY: Aspirin, Paracetamol, Diosmectite, Strepsils, Betadine)
- For specific conditions such as motion sickness or ear-nose-related issues, please ensure you bring along any required medications

ACCESSORIES (optional, according to personal preferences)

- Dive gear bag
- Mesh bag for wet gear
- Gear hangers
- Gear straps and clips

DIVERSE STUFFS

- Cash (for tips, extras, and souvenirs)
- Reusable water bottle
- Dry bag or waterproof pouch
- Notepad and pen

ELECTRONICS

- Underwater camera and accessories
- Chargers for all electronic devices

We have EU type plug aboard, please bring adaptor for US and UK type chargers



DON'T FORGET:

① Beverage Availability.

We are pleased to offer beer and wine for purchase aboard the ship. The price for a can of Stella beer is 2.5 EUR, and a bottle of wine is available for 15 EUR. We provide a selection of red, rose, and white wines. Our onboard stock is limited. We recommend pre-ordering to ensure availability and avoid any inconvenience.

② Dive Insurance

Verify that your dive insurance is up-to-date and covers the specific location and activities planned. All additional services are payable CASH ABOARD only in EURO, USD. We do not accept EGP. Prepare cash in advance. The boat doesn't accept cards.

③ Reusable thermos/cup

Kindly consider bringing your reusable personal cup or thermos to utilise with our onboard water boiler during the week. Remember to stay hydrated! Minimising the use of disposable cups = save ecology.



④ Toiletries Provision

Ship does not supply toiletries such as shampoo or shower gel. Only hand soap is provided for your convenience. During the week, we typically offer two towels per guest—one for bathroom use and another for outdoor activities. Towel replacements are not provided during the week. Bring any additional towels you may require.

⑤ Buffet-style meals

Onboard, we offer buffet-style meals tailored to your dietary requirements. We always have a dedicated vegetarian section available. If you have specific dietary requirements or food allergies, please inform us in advance.
